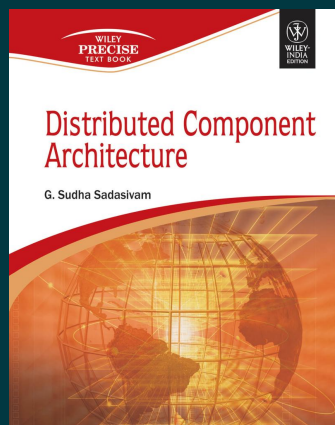




Distributed Component Architecture
