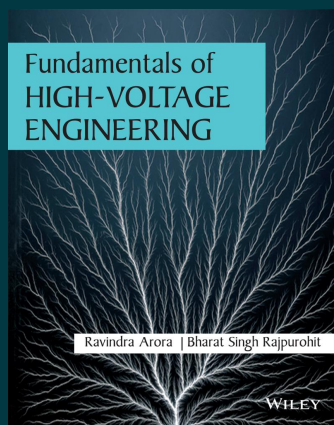




Fundamentals of High-Voltage Engineering
