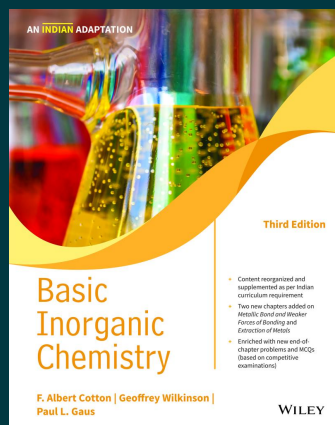




Basic Inorganic Chemistry, 3ed (An Indian Adaptation)
