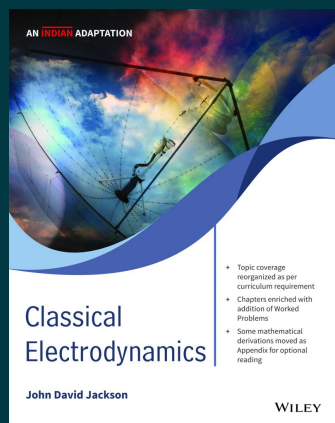




Classical Electrodynamics, An Indian Adaptation
